Student Travel to Required Rotation Sites Policy

Students are responsible for their own transportation to and from all assigned clinical rotation sites. The program considers commutable distances to be up to 100 miles from campus one way. Additionally, some clinical sites may be located outside the local area, requiring long-distance travel. Travel, lodging, meals, parking, and other costs related to clinical training are considered part of the educational expenses of the program.

Students generally cannot decline or request reassignment to a different site based solely on travel distance or convenience. Exceptions are granted only for ADA accommodation.
